Maureen was a special education teacher in the Waterloo and Cedar Falls school districts for over 30 years.

AAUW Title IX Champion awards were presented to Charlotte Nelson, in absentia, and Lori SchraderBachar in recognition of their work with the Iowa Commission on the Status of Women. Mary Harlan was recognized for her 50 years of AAUW membership.

Elected or re-elected to the Branch leadership team were Faith Sherman, president, Barb Zimany, treasurer, Amy Getty, newsletter editor and membership chair, Mary Harlan, public policy, Fran Shoop, publicity, Sharon Gee, and Brittany Cottrill. The 2015-16 budget was presented by treasurer Barb Zimany. Income from dues is expected to be \$2650.00. The financial report for 2014-15 showed a closing balance of \$5076.85 in working funds and \$1051.77 in reserved funds.
